## Elections of Directors: Positions for Directors are elected for 2-year terms

- Georgann Kishner was appointed Inspector of Elections.
- 2024 Maureen Devane, Amy Bonacci and Stan Kishner were unanimously re-elected.
- Election as Representative to the Master Board Stan Kishner was unanimously re-elected.

## **New Business**

- New Insurance Policy
  - In 2023, Annual premium increased from \$224,804 to \$413,094
  - o New Premium is TBD
  - o Deductibles will be the same: \$10k \$50k
- Roof Replacement
  - o 2024 Willows (Cypress) \$457k completed
  - o 2025 Summit (Pinnacle) \$618k
- Stoop Replacement
  - o There are 188 pre-cast stoops in Sterling Woods II
  - o By the end of 2024, we will have replaced 82
  - o Additional replacements will continue for several years
  - o Cost per stoop is about \$8k (plus some landing replacements)

- Pine / Spruce Tree Removal
  - Project is complete
  - Weeds that arise where grass has been planted to be addressed in the Spring 2025
  - Addition of more plantings to provide privacy in the Birches and other villages to be discussed by the Board
  - O Birches owners can procure additional plants on their own with permission from the landscaping committee; care of these plants would be unit owner responsibility
- No Prune List
  - No pruning list was eliminated earlier this year (Birches was outvoted 5:1)
  - Concern with unit owners who did not properly care for their shrubs (primarily in other villages)
  - o We offered a proposal which is being considered committee formed
- Deck Replacement 2026 or beyond (composite decking and railings)
- 2025 Budget being prepared by Treasurers' Committee
  - o To be presented to the Master Board at November meeting
  - Anticipate year-end assessment of \$300-\$400 (average) to repay \$75k loan from reserve account + budget overage from storm damage in 2024.

## **Questions and Comments**

- Tony Molinaro thanks Stan for an excellent job for all he does and for being transparent. He is only one voice and is appreciated!
- Jim Harlow expressed concern about remaining privacy issues in the Birches and the need for transparency in how decisions are made in allocating funds to different villages.
- What are the plans to be more involved in decision making? Decisions need to be more coordinated. Stan will report on this after addressing the Master Board.
