REI Property Management - Upcoming Phone System Changes and IT Upgrades

REI will be upgrading its IT infrastructure to enhance reliability and better support for our clients beginning on Monday, March 23, 2026. As a part of this upgrade, callers will experience a new auto-attendant and call routing system designed to improve call handling efficiency. Please note that as of March 23rd, extensions will transition from three digits to four digits and existing extensions will be retained with the number “1” added to the beginning. So as of March 23rd, Kim Murray’s extension will be 1153.
